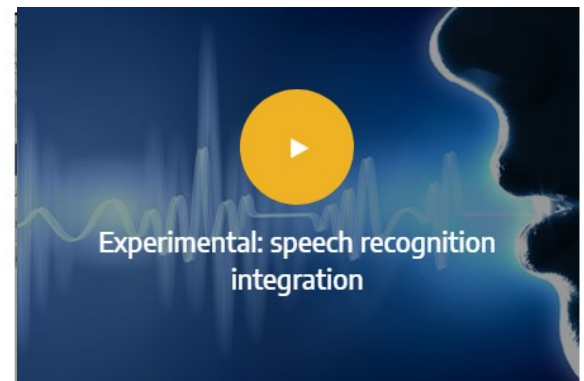

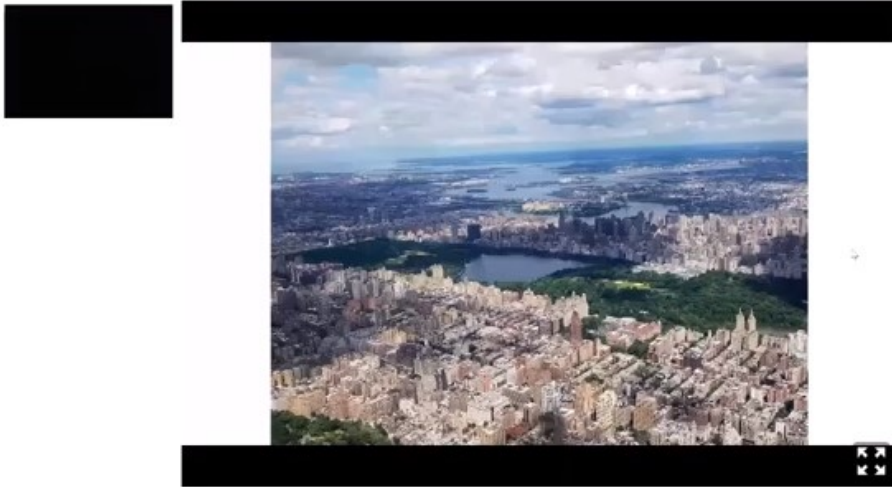

CONCLUDING REMARKS

Currently, interpreting might be on the verge of a third breakthrough which I will call, for lack of a better term, the technological turn in interpreting. Bigger by one order of magnitude if compared to the first two breakthroughs, its pervasiveness and the changes that it may bring about could reach a level that has the potential to **radically change** the profession. (Fantinuoli, 2018)

Technology literacy is rapidly becoming a **key asset** for anyone on the labor market, including interpreters. (Drechsel, 2019)
